WASHINGTON, D.C., Jan. 5, 1972 ----- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole, Kansas Republicans, announced today a federal grant to a Lawrence firm to finance a study of the operation of day care centers currently in use around the country.

The grant for \$59,650 from the Office of Economic Opportunity will go to the Center for Applied Behavior Analysis, Inc. in Lawrence. The Kansas Senators said that the aim of the study is to point out the most effective, economical and efficient types of child care arrangements in order to determine which might be best adopted on a national basis.

Todd Risley will supervise the Lawrence project.
