WASHINGTON, D.C., JANUARY 20, 1972 -- U.S. Senator Bob Dole today announced that the General Services Administration is seeking office space in Kansas City, Kansas for the new ACTION agency.

ACTION has been established as an independent agency of the executive branch to bring together, within a single agency, a number of voluntary action programs. It includes SCORE (Service Corp of Retired Executives), ACE (Active Corp of Executives), VISTA (Volunteers in Service to America) and RSVP (Retired Senior Volunteer Programs).

Senator Dole said the proposed area ^{for the building} is bounded by Washington Blvd. on the north, 12th Street on the west, Central Ave. on the south and Interstate 70 and Third Street on the east.

Dole said, "The new ACTION agency will bring to Kansas City, Kansas a great number of needed services on a volunteer based program. It will provide a much needed program, at little expense to the taxpayer, for many of the people of Kansas."
