WASHINGTON, D.C., FEB. 9, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced the Farmers Home Administration has approved a \$140,000 loan to Rural Water District #3 in Jackson County, Kansas.

The Kansas Senators said the loan funds will enable the district to enlarge and expand the planned water system which was originally financed in June 1971 with a \$353,900 loan and \$107,900 grant from FHA. Fifty-one rural families in the towns of Circleville, Mayetta, Netawaka and Denison in Jackson County will benefit from the modern water facilities provided by the District.
