WASHINGTON, D.C. March 1, 1972 ----- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson, Bob Dole, and U.S. Rep. Larry Winn, Kansas Republicans, announced today a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development to the city of Kansas City, Kansas, in the amount of \$264,648.

The Neighborhood Facilities grant is for the construction of a multi-purpose facility to be used for meeting needs of residents for a program of health, recreation, social and other similar community services. The facility will be a two-story 15,000-foot structure constructed of concrete blocks faced with brick.

The project is known as the Bethany Park Community Center and is located about a mile south of the central business district. The site is on 11th Street between Central Avenue and Reynolds Avenue in Bethany Park.
