FHA LOAN TO SHAWNEE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

WASHINGTON, D.C., March 23 ---- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole announced today the confirmation of a Farmers Home Administration (FHA) loan of \$67,000 to the Rural Water District No. 10 in Shawnee County.

The funds, to be repaid in 40 years at the rate of five per cent interest, will be used for a rural water system to supply 55 users. According to the Kansas Republicans, the facility will consist of about 14 miles of water lines, a booster pump and a standpipe. Water will be purchased from the city of Silver Lake. The district is located in northwest Shawnee County. The ^{567,000} \$67 loan will supplement a \$10,000 district contribution to complete the system.
