WASHINGTON, D.C., MAR. 28, 1972 -- U.S. Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that the National Science Foundation has awarded two grants to Kansas State University and one to the University of Kansas.

A research grant of \$62,900 was awarded to Dr. Robert J. Robel, professor of biology, for a two month study of, "Pesticide, Parasite, Energetic and Behavioral Interactions." The research will extend for 24 months.

An award of \$18,000 went to the Chemistry Department of K-State for the purchase of a Digital Data System. Dr. A.H. Daane is the head of that department.

The University of Kansas received a research contract for \$6,200 for a study entitled, "Solvability of Differential Equations and Index Theory." The research will be headed by Robert D. Moyer of the mathematics department. The project will last for one year.
