WASHINGTON, D.C., MAR. 29, 1972 -- U.S. Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Office of Economic Opportunity has awarded three grants to Kansas.

The first, an administration grant for general community programming, legal services and senior opportunities and services for 12 months duration. Amount of grant, \$634,000 for Wyandotte Co.

Second, A \$97,350 grant to the Wyandotte County Legal Aid Society. This grant will serve Wyandotte Co. for 12 months starting April 1.

The third, An administration and general community programming grant for \$140,097 to the East Central Kansas Economic Opportunity Corporation in Ottawa. This grant will serve Franklin, Douglas, Osage, Coffey and Lyon counties for the next 12 months.
