WASHINGTON, D.C., April 25, 1972 ---- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole, Kansas Republicans, announced today a \$356,090 grant from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to the Kansas Regional Medical Program, Kansas City, Kansas.
