WASHINGTON, D.C., MAY 12, 1972 -- The office of Senator Bob Dole today conducted a random telephone survey to determine what support President Nixon's recent actions relative to the war in Southeast Asia had in Kansas.

Nineteen communities were called and over 25 individuals were asked, "Do you support President Nixon's recent actions relative to the war in Vietnam?"

The results? Sixty percent of those asked responded with an affirmative yes, 12 percent no, 8 percent said they lacked sufficient information and 20 percent were at that time undecided.
