WASHINGTON, D.C., MAY 24, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Urban Renewal Agency in Manhattan, Kansas received a \$992,000 Neighborhood Development Program grant from HUD.

The aim of this program, the Senators explained, is to improve environment by treating sub-standard dwellings, over crowding, detrimental land uses and obsolete building types.

First year acquisition estimates are; acquisition of 67 panels, demolition of 70 structures, relocation of 82 families and rehabilitation of 36 dwellings.
