WASHINGTON, D.C., -- JUNE 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that a \$15,000 HUD grant was awarded to Kansas City, Kansas. The funds will be used to conduct an analysis of housing projects in that area.

The socioeconomic characteristics of the residents will be studied along with a study of political, procedural, and financial workability of current housing programs. Recommendations for actions to be taken will be made.

Also awarded to Kansas City, Kansas, was an open space grant of \$266,359 for the aquisition of two new sites; a 15 acre site and a 9.4 acre tract. The money will also be used to develop ten other existing sites.
