WASHINGTON, D.C., JUNE 27, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today grants totaling \$6,925,090 to Kansas from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The list of projects include:

Salina, \$969,090 for 100 single family dwelling units.

Hill City, \$480,000 for 25 single family dwelling units.

Manhattan, \$1,480,000 for 60 dwelling units in north Manhattan and \$522,000 for 24 units in the Meadowbrook Development.

Nicodemas, \$14,000 for 10 dwelling units.

Valley Falls, \$480,000 for 24 dwelling units of which 16 specified for the elderly.

Leavenworth, \$2,500,000 for 100 dwelling units for the elderly.
