WASHINGTON, D.C., August 3, 1972 -- Senator Bob Dole introduced legislation on the Senate floor yesterday to authorize payments established by the Indian Claims Commission to the Iowa Indian tribes of Kansas, Nebraska and Oklahoma.

The funds, totaling \$633,193.77 will be distributed among 1,740 individuals located in Brown County, Kansas, and Richardson County, Nebraska. Funds will also be distributed to the Iowa Indian tribe of Oklahoma.

The Kansas Senator said: "I am hopeful that this authorization bill can be acted upon promptly so that this obligation owed by the United States to the people of the Iowa Tribes may finally be met."
