WASHINGTON, D.C., SEPT. 27, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that Manhattan will receive an increase of \$774,400 from the Environmental Protection Agency on a grant to improve the Manhattan sewerage system.

The increase brings the total amount to \$1,936,000 for construction of a new 54 inch interceptor sewer to run from the existing pump station to the new waste treatment plant. The funds will also be used to construct a new secondary waste treatment plant.

This increase brings the EPA portion to a full 55% (the maximum under law) of the total project cost of \$3,520,000.
