WASHINGTON, D.C., OCT. 2, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressman Garner Shriver today announced that the Air Force has awarded two contracts, worth a total of \$2,923,621, to Boeing Co. in Wichita.

One contract is a supplemental agreement for depot-level maintenance of B-52 aircraft to be performed at Boeing and SAC bases. The total value of the contract is \$3,980,975 with \$1,273,975 being obligated today, \$2,707,000 had previously been obligated.

The other contract is for Corrosion Correction and Repainting of B-52 aircraft. The work is to be performed at Wichita. The total contract value is \$4,926,386 with \$1,649,646 being obligated today.
