WASHINGTON, D.C., FEB. 7, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced four grants from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for Kansas. They are:

A \$135,000 College Grant to Bethany College in Lindsborg for alteration of the Student Union Building.

A \$65,584 Neighborhood Facilities Grant for Bethany Park in Kansas City to construct a multi-purpose facility to provide community services to the local residents.

A \$34,124 Neighborhood Facilities Grant to the Board of County Commissioners of Kiowa to construct a neighborhood facility to be known as Kiowa County Multiple-Use Center.

A \$462,968 Low-Rent Housing Modernization Program Grant to the Housing Authority of the City of Topeka for Pine Ridge, Deer Creek, Western Plaza, and Polk Plaza to install off-street parking, extend playground areas and to construct a new community building.
