WASHINGTON, D.C., FEB. 22, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole has been reappointed to the U.S. National Commission for the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

The U.S. National Commission for UNESCO is a 100 member body of citizens and non-governmental organizations which advises the Department of State on matters of international matters of science, culture, education and communications.

Senator Dole's first appointment was from 1970 to 1972, his new appointment is through 1975.
