WASHINGTON, D.C., APR. 8, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today was awarded a \$500 contribution for the Institute of Logopedics in Wichita by Tom Stabler, President of the Montgomery County, Maryland Chapter of the Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barber Shop Quartet Singing in America.

The Institute of Logopedics was founded in Wichita in 1934 to help to adults and children suffering from speech handicaps. Since that time it has treated more than 35,000 persons. The Institute now operates field offices throughout Kansas that offer services to at least 2,000 Kansans each year.

Becky Sinclair, a staff assistant in the office of Senator Dole accepted the contribution for the Kansas Senator.
