WASHINGTON, D.C. -- In action earlier today the Senate passed a proposal by Senator Bob Dole to reinstate the REAP program.

Dole had recently introduced this legislation but took the opportunity afforded by Senate consideration of the Farm Bill to include REAP as an amendment to the bill.

In urging Senate adoption of this proposal Dole said that the practices being reinstated are important to rural and urban America, and should be supported as a wise and prudent investment in the future of our country. The proposal was passed by unanimous consent.
