WASHINGTON, D.C. -- In response to requests from Senator Bob Dole it has been learned that Secretary of Agriculture Earl Butz plans to make loans available for grain stored in temporary facilities, or on the ground due to a shortage of storage space and freight cars. The loans are expected to be 75% of the normal loan level.

Senator Dole has also rearned that the Department of Transportation and the Interstate Commerce Commission are planning to dispatch representatives into the harvest areas to assist in the movement of grain.
