WASHINGTON, D.C. -- In response to requests from Senator Bob Dole, it has been learned that, Secretary of Agriculture Earl Butz, plans to make loans available for grain stored in temporary facilities, or on the ground due to a shortage of storage space and freight cars. The loans are expected to be 75% of the normal loan level.

Senator Dole has also ^{been advised} learned that the Department of Transportation, and the Interstate Commerce Commission, are planning to dispatch representatives, into the harvest areas, to assist in the movement of grain.
