WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole, James Pearson, and Congressman Larry Winn today announced the award<sup>ing</sup> of over \$1.5 million to Schools of Medicine, Pharmacy and Veterinary Medicine in Kansas. Recipients are the University of Kansas School of Medicine, \$1,191,507; the University of Kansas School of Pharmacy, \$79,835; and the College of Veterinary Medicine, Kansas State University, \$238,981.

The funds are being awarded under the Health Professions Capitation Grant Program established to improve the quality of schools of Medicine, Dentistry, Osteopathy, Optometry and Podiatry.

Earlier this week, \$331,701 in grants were awarded to the University of Kansas School of Medicine under the Health Profession Special Project Grants program to be utilized for preceptorship training and programs aimed at helping the School develop a curriculum which better meets the needs of the State.
