WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole and Congressman Keith Sebelius today announced that some 400 modified open hopper cars would soon be available for grain transportation along the Burlington Northern Line. Dole and Debelius learned of the development late Thursday afternoon from ICC chairman George Stafford.

Dole said, " these cars should help to significantly ease the squeeze on grain storage facilities in the Northwestern tier of Kansas counties served by the Burlington Northern." These counties include Cheyenne, Rawlins, Decatur, and Norton.
