Senator Bob Dole announced today that the Senate by a vote of 97-0 has granted final passage to the Emergency Medical Service System Act of 1973. The bill will now go to the White House for the President's signature.

Commenting on the bill Senator Dole said, "This measure is intended to provide assistance to local communities to help them improve emergency medical care systems. It is especially important to the many Kansas Communities which are developing ambulance services and other programs to assure that emergency medical care is available at all times to all their residents. I am hopeful the program can be operative in the near future."
