WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that Claud R. McCamment of Topeka had been appointed to the Citizen's Advisory Committee on Transportation Quality.

McCamment will serve a three year term on the Committee which functions as a citizens' sounding board assessing Department of Transportation policies from the viewpoint of the consumer and advises the Secretary of Transportation on these matters.

Dole, who recommended McCamment for the position, said that "Claud is particularly well suited for membership on the committee in view of his long experience in transportation policy matters in Kansas." McCamment is presently Safety Director for the Kansas State Highway Commission. In addition, he has had some three decades of experience in developing and administering transportation and safety programs for Kansas, for the U.S. Army, and for the American Automobile Association.
