SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDS ADDITIONAL JUDGE FOR KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole announced today from Washington that the Senate subcommittee on improvements in judicial machinery had approved the creation of an additional federal judgeship for Kansas.

Dole said, "This is a step which I have been urging for some time now. I believe the additional judgeship is vitally necessary to meet the pressing need in Kansas for more judicial manpower to help handle the burden of an increasing federal court case load."

The recommendation of the subcommittee now awaits action by the full Senate Judiciary Committee before going to the Senate for action.
