WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Topeka can expect soon to have the use of three facilities at Forbes Air Force base under interim use agreements worked out with the Air Force, and announced by Senator Bob Dole.

The facilities involved are the Skill Center and Dental Clinic, buildings 2704 and 282 on the base, along with the base golf course. The SkillCenter and the Dental Clinic buildings will be transferred to the Topeka school district authorities for use by the city as a Vocational Technical Training School. The golf course presently has nine holes and under the Air Force order will be transmitted along with sufficient area for expansion to an eighteen hole course.

The announcement by Dole came as the Air Force Department sent a directive dated July 30th to the Corps of Engineers instructing the Corps to execute the transfer of property.

The Air Force directive instructs the Corps of Engineers to expedite action on the transfers of the facilities along with associated equipment and adjacent land for parking.
