WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole said today that he was confident that Congressional action on the 1973 Farm Bill would be completed soon, probably late today. Dole said that Congressional conferees, who had been working to iron out differences between the House and Senate versions of the bill, had agreed to a responsible compromise which should be acceptable to all interested parties.

"The final bill isn't perfect in all respects, but it is a good compromise. I believe it will be signed into law by the President.", Dole added.
