WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole today said that he had received a letter from Arthur Sampson, Administrator of the General Services Administration, indicating that the prospectus on the Wichita Federal Building should be complete and ready for submission to the Office of Management and Budget within 90 days.

Senator Dole and Congressman Garner Shriver have been in contact with GSA urging that the prospectus be given priority consideration.

GSA action on the prospectus has been delayed by the lack of a determination by the U.S. Courts as to their space requirements in the proposed building. The Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts had indicated a preference for retaining Court facilities in the existing Post Office and Courthouse. However, it was subsequently determined that the space to be vacated by the Postal Service was not sufficient to satisfy the U.S. Court requirements.
