WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced the awarding of grants totaling \$232,630 from the Department of Labor to five Kansas communities. The grants will be used to fund Neighborhood Youth Corps Programs serving 614 youths.

- \$83,730 -- Southeast Kansas Community Action Program, Inc., Girard
- \$25,550 -- Northeast Kansas Community Action Program, Inc., Horton
- \$32,920 -- East Central Kansas Community Action Program, Ottawa
- \$45,050 -- Economic Opportunity Foundation, Inc., Kansas City
- \$45,380 -- Unified School District #259, Wichita

Operation Mainstream funds totaling \$50,040 went to three Kansas communities to supply paid work experience for some 60 mature workers who have suffered chronic unemployment.

- \$23,670 -- Girard for 33 enrollees
- \$25,240 -- Winfield Unified School District #465 -for 15 enrollees
- \$1,130 -- Ottawa for 12 enrollees
