GENERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS TO KANSAS

Washington D.C. - Senator Bob Dole announced today the payment of \$659,448 to 142 units of local government within the State of Kansas. This special payment is being made to those jurisdictions who had missed the first quarter allocation of 1974 revenue sharing monies because reports on the uses and planned uses of the funds had been received after the September 25th reporting deadline. Today's payments go to those jurisdictions which have now met the reporting requirements, and the Department of Treasury has scheduled another special payment in November for those units of local government whose reports are received by October 31st.

According to the General Revenue Sharing Law, each recipient of general revenue sharing funds must report on the actual use of the revenue sharing funds it expended prior to June 30, 1973 and also must indicate the planned use of funds to be received through fiscal year 1974. The law also requires that this report be published locally in a newspaper of general circulation.

More than 600 units of local government had not fulfilled reporting requirements and therefore did not receive their first quarter allocation of revenue sharing funds for FY 1974 when it was made October 1st.
