CANCER CENTER FUNDS

WASHINGTON, D. C. -- Senators Bob Dole, James Pearson and Congressman Larry Winn announced today the award of nearly a quarter million dollars to the Kansas University Medical Center for the operation of a National Cancer Research and Demonstration Center.

The grant will provide core support for the operation of the Center during the next two years, as the Medical Center continues to build a comprehensive Regional program of cancer research, detection, and treatment. The Director of the Cancer Center, Dr. James Lowman, indicated that the Center would also be applying for more specialized grants and contracts from the National Cancer Institute to carry out specific programs.

"The University of Kansas Medical Center Cancer Program has been outstanding," Dole said, "and through the continued support of the National Cancer Institute, it will be able to expand its programs of cancer research, detection, and treatment to all residents of Kansas and the Midwest."
