COMMUNITY PROGRAMMING GRANT TO GIRARD

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressman Joe Skubitz today announced the awarding of a \$67,500 Administration and General Community Programming Grant to Sek-Cap, Inc. of Girard, Kansas. The grant will run for three months beginning December 1, 1973.

James W. Garrison will be director of the project that will be serving Allen, Bourbon, Linn, Crawford, Cherokee, Labette, and Montgomery counties.

The ^{Program} will provide for the administration and management of the community action agency, for pre-vocational and vocational training, for basic automotive training skills and supportive services to high school drop-outs, for tutorial services for high school, junior college, and college students. It will also organize and operate a transportation service and continue outreach activities.
