HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT TO KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today the apportionment of \$70,438 to Kansas for historic preservation.

This allocation will support ongoing programs and Bicentennial projects and must be matched by recipients with non-federal funds or in-kind donations.

Until now historic preservation grants have been awarded by the federal government of a single project basis rather than the one larger grant to be used for multiple projects being awarded this year. This overall grant broadens the role of localities in deciding how to use grant funds.

The Kansas grant will be administered through the State Historic Preservation Officer, Nyle H. Miller.
