Wash., D.C., Nov. 28, 1973. Senator Bob Dole (R-Kan) said late this afternoon that he had been assured that President Nixon now has under active consideration a proposal to modify the original announcement with respect to cut-backs on fuel for general aviation.

Dole said that since meeting with general aviation officials, including representatives from Beech and Cessna aircraft companies, he had discussed what he termed "the gross inequity" in the newly announced policy with administration officials and had urged immediate reconsideration.

Late this afternoon he received verification that the President was reviewing a plan to restore a greater element of balance in the fuel policy on general aviation.
