## MAY ADD GENERAL AVIATION FUEL AMENDMENT TO DAYLIGHT BILL, SAYS DOLE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today in Washington that he may add to the Daylight Savings Bill, a fuel allocation amendment designed to ensure that no class or category of users is discriminated against in allocation programs.

"The President's week-end decision to modify the fuel allocation plans for general aviation seems to have provided equity for general aviation," Dole said, "but there may still be some justification for writing that requirement for non-discrimination into law. So long as the law allows for needed flexibility in the administration of the allocation programs, then perhaps it would be well**to** whake the intent of Congress clear on the point."

Dole said that there was some opposition to the proposed amendment in the Congress and among certain Senators who had the impression that the amendment would do more than it does. "All the amendment would assure," he said, "is that fuel users with equal priorities get equal consideration in the allocation programs."

Dole said he was considering adding it to the Daylight Savings Time Bill because the efforts to pass it in the House were being delayed as the Emergency Energy Act was stalled in the House Committee. The Daylight Savings Time Bill is expected to come to a vote in the Senate tomorrow. It has already passed the House and once the Senate acts, could conceivably become law within days.
