DOLE ON TWA STRIKE

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Senator Bob Dole this morning contacted Mr. David Stowe, Chairman of the National Mediation Board to discuss the status of negotiations on the TWA strike.

Mr. Stowe informed the Senator that there had been intense negotiations during all tof the past weekend and that another meeting was planned to start at 2:00 this afternoon.

After his conversation with Stowe, Dole commented, "I remain hopeful that the labor dispute will be resolved to the satisfaction of all parties concerned as quickly as possible. It is apparent that some hard bargaining lies ahead, but I am confident that with good will on both sides, the matter can be settled."

I HAVE TODAY BEEN IN CONTACT WITH MR. DAVID STOWE, WHO IS CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL MEDIATION BOARD. WE DISCUSSED THE STATUS OF NEGOTIATIONS ON THE TWA STRIKE.

STOWE TOLD ME THAT THERE HAD BEEN INTENSE NEGOTIATIONS
DURING ALL OF THIS PAST WEEKEND AND THAT ANOTHER MEETING WAS
PLANNED TO START AT TWO O'CLOCK THIS AFTERNOON.

I REMAIN HOPEFUL THAT THE LABOR DISPUTE WILL BE
RESOLVED TO THE SATISFACTION OF ALL PARTIES CONCERNED AS
QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE. IT IS APPARENT THAT SOME HARD BARGAINING
LIES AHEAD, BUT I AM CONFIDENT THAT WITH GOOD WILL ON BOTH
SIDES, THE MATTER CAN BE SETTLED.
