## DOLE CONTACTS FEDERAL DISASTER OFFICE AFTER ICE STORM

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said he had been in contact with the Director of the Federal Disaster Assistance field office in Kansas after learning of the damaging ice storm that hit areas of Kansas overnight.

Dole said he had received numerous reports of downed trees and power lines and of interrupted utilities services. He said the Federal Disaster officials in Kansas were looking into the matter and would be reporting back to him.
