AG MIDDLE DISTILLATE ALLOCATION TO BE 110% of PAST USE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole learned today that the allocations for middle distillate fuels for agriculture in the coming year will be made at the rate of 110% of actual use for the base period from November 1972 to November 1973. Gasoline and propane will be allocated at 100% of need.

Dole said he had learned of the plan from Agriculture Secretary Earl Butz Wednesday morning.

Dole said he welcomed the establishment of this allocation for agriculture because "it is necessary that American food producers, who are being asked to go all out in food production this year, have some assurance that their fuel requirements are understood and that steps are being taken to make sure that the need is met."
