DOLE, WHITE HOUSE ON TWA STRIKE

WASHINGTON D.C.--Senator Bob Dole today said he had learned of high White House interest in the settlement of the TransWorld Airlines strike.

"I have been informed that efforts toward a solution of the dispute are receiving top level attention at the White House," Dole said.

The Senator reported that this information had come in response to his request to the President yesterday for appointment of an emergency fact-finding board.

"The seriousness of this strike--to Kansas City, Wichita and to the traveling public--is receiving priority consideration. I am hopeful these efforts will lead to early success in the negotiations and prompt resumption of TWA operations before the holiday travel season gets under way," Senator Dole said.
