CLINTON PARKWAY PROBLEMS TO GET HEARING

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today that at his urging, the Senate Public Works Committee will give the problems of the Clinton Parkway full consideration in hearings to be scheduled in the near future.

"I appeared to discuss the Clinton Parkway during executive session deliberations on the 1973 Water Resources Act," Senator Dole said. "At that time the Committee indicated its understanding of the problems facing Lawrence and Douglas County. But there was a feeling that a more complete study should precede legislative action.

"The Committee's discussion of the Clinton Parkway problem in its report on the Water Resources Act is very frank and forthright. And the commitment to schedule hearings in early 1974 is a most encouraging response to my request."
