WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare had awarded a \$22,697.35 contract for the drilling of seven water wells at individual homes of the Potowotomie Indian tribe in Jackson county.

The contract was awarded to the Strader Drilling Company in Holton.
