## KANSAS RECEIVES RECORD ALLOCATION OF LOAN FUNDS FOR RURAL HOUSING

WASH. (AP) -- Senator Bob Dole said today through his Washington office that the Kansas Farmers Home Administration had received a record rural housing loan allocation totalling \$19,350,000 for Fiscal Year 1974.

The total figure breaks down to an allocation of \$17.2 million for loans for the purchase of single family dwellings and \$2.15 million for rental housing loans.

According to Morgan Williams, Kansas Farmers Home Administrator, these loans can be used for the purchase of existing housing and new homes as well as for rental, and home repair in towns of less than 10,000 population. The loans are made under the Rural Housing program of the United States Department of Agriculture. Dole said that anyone interested in the program can obtain further information from their nearest FHA office.
