FHA GRANTS 3 LOANS TO KANSAS

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that the Farmers Home Administration is awarding 3 loans to Kansas totalling \$678,700.

Rural Water District No. 2 in Republic County will receive \$653,100 to complete its water distribution system consisting of 290 miles of water lines, four standpipes and two wells in the area around Belleville to the Nebraska state line and extending service into the towns of Narka and Munden. Mr. Paul Shoemaker of Narka is chairman of the Republic County Rural Water District No. 2.

Rural Water District No. 1 of Crawford County will receive \$16,000 to add 16 connections to its water system improvement project now under construction to develop central water service for 123 homes and other establishments in a section of the county southeast of Arma. Chairman of Rural Water District No. 1 is Mr. Roy Morey of Routel, Pittsburg.

The Smoky Valley Grazing Association of Logan County will receive \$9,600 to buy an additional 160 acres of land to be used by association members as a means of increasing their livestock production. Mr. Harley Hershberger of Russell Springs, is president of the Smokey Valley Grazing Association.
