FUEL ALLOCATIONS ANNOUNCED, GENERAL AVIATION GETS EQUITY

Abilene, Kan. -- Senator Bob Dole voiced satisfaction that the fuel allocations for general aviation which were announced Tuesday "seem to meet the requirements of equity which we had been seeking to ensure in discussions with the administration and through legislative action."

Dole said that the general aviation allocations overall permit distribution of 95 percent of the total base period use. The base period is the calendar month of 1972 corresponding to the current month.

The 95 percent total, when broken down, allocates 100 percent of current need for certain high priority uses, agricultural production flying, energy production flying and aircraft manufacturing. The allocation for business flying is 90 percent and the allocation for personal, pleasure and instructional flying is 75 percent.
