FHA LOAN TO BROWN COUNTY

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$206,000 Farmers Home Administration loan to Rural Water District No. 1 of Brown County to complete the funding of its project to build a central water system. The agency previously has approved \$370,000 of loan financing for the project.

The district will install a 90-mile system of water distribution line drawing its supply from six wells and serving about 245 families in Fairview, Hamlin and vicinity, as well as providing a source of water supply to town systems in Morrill and Reserve. The system will relieve many families from the necessity of hauling water for household and farm use, and will improve the water supply for livestock in the area.

Reuben Mellenbruch of Fairview is chairman of the water district.
