CITY'S GAS PROBLEMS ALLEVIATED

WASHINGTON, D.C.-- After conferring with the Federal Energy Office, Senator Bob Dole announced today that recent problems the City of Topeka has had getting gasoline should be resolved very soon.

Topeka's supplier had not been able to supply the City with enough gasoline to operate the City's police and other official vehicles. Dole said that Energy officials have assured him that gasoline is already on the way to meet the City's immediate needs and that a solution has also been worked out to deal with the problem on a continuing and permanent basis.
