KANSAN GEORGE STAFFORD APPROVED BY SENATE COMMITTEE FOR SECOND TERM

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today that the Senate Commerce Committee, in a unanimous action, has approved the re-nomination of George Stafford, Interstate Commerce Commission Chairman, to a second full seven-year term on the Commission. Stafford, the first Kansan to serve on the ICC and a native of Valley Falls, was originally appointed to the Commission by President Lyndon Johnson in 1967. President Nixon appointed him Chairman in May of 1970.
