DOLE INTRODUCES CLINTON PARKWAY BILL

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole has introduced a bill authorizing \$6 million for construction of the Clinton Parkway in Douglas County.

Late Friday, Senator Dole introduced legislation which would provide a vital 4.1 mile access road between Clinton Lake and the intersection of 23rd and Iowa Streets in Lawrence.

"An estimated 10,000 vehicles per day will be drawn to Clinton Lake when it begins operation, and the roads in the vicinity must be safe and adequate. After much discussion and study, it appears that special legislation is the only way to avoid serious hazzard, inconvenience and disruption when the Lake opens as one of the most attractive recreation areas in Kansas," Senator Dole said.

"I have been assured by Senator Jennings Randolph (D-W.Va.) Chairman of the Senate Public Works Committee that the Clinton road problem will receive full and careful consideration, so I am hopeful that hearings on my bill can be set at an early date."
