DOLE ANNOUNCES AG RESEARCH FUNDS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole today applauded an increase of \$135,700 in funds for research at the U.S. Grain Marketing Research Center, Manhattan.

"In view of the increasingly tight supply of food grains throughout the world," Dole said, "I am glad to see this increase in funding. However, the Grain Marketing Research Center in Manhattan should receive full funding and full staffing. Wheat and other Kansas-produced grains are bailing out the rest of the economy through export revenues which which provide a basis for the purchase of oil and other essentials from foreign markets. ~~I intend to~~ continue pressing for full funding of the lab since it can be of great benefit to agriculture in Kansas and other states."

The additional funds are for research on improved methods for protecting and measuring grain quality and are being used by the USDA's Agricultural Research Service.
